### **Dates for 2011-2012 School year**

November 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade only

February 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> for 12<sup>th</sup> grade only

March 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> for 10<sup>th</sup> grade only

May 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> for 10<sup>th</sup> grade make up and 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade

### **Requirements for passing the exit exam.**

All students must receive at least a score of 350 or more.

### **Consequences of not passing the exam.**

All California schools are unable to provide a diploma to a student who has fulfilled all academic requirements without passing one or both sections of the CAHSEE. The school is legally obligated to offer the test three times a year for two years after a student has fulfilled all the academic requirements
