

Forest Charter School – Snow Day Information

Above all, please keep in mind that our main concern is your safety. One of the great things about a personalized learning program is that learning continues despite a snag in location. Please use good judgment and travel only if it is safe for you to do so.

Due to the diverse geography of our school, the different learning centers (i.e. Nevada City, Foresthill, and Truckee) will each make an individual determination as to whether or not to run the learning center classes and/or cooperative classes. We will do everything we can to inform you of our decision in a timely manner.

Nevada City Learning Center

- FCS will notify you via a School Messenger phone call and/or email
- FCS will post information on the homepage of the website
- FCS will contact KNCO and KVMR with our status – Listen to KNCO and KVMR for an announcement and/or check their webpage for information.

Truckee Learning Center

- FCS will notify you via a SchoolMessenger phone call and send an email to notify families of the snow day by 7am that day, or if possible, the night before a school day.
- FCS Truckee Learning Center calls a snow day when the Tahoe Truckee Unified School District calls a snow day. A Snow day for FCS means no classes on campus. Students are expected to check www.schoolpathways.com to check what their teachers assign for independent study work for that day. This is still a day of schoolwork for our students, just not a day on campus for classes. The work assigned that day for class will be due the next day of class.
- FCS will not do a delayed start like TTUSD. We will start all of our classes on schedule.

Foresthill Learning Center

- FCS will notify you via a School Messenger phone call and/or email
- If power is out and we cannot do an all-call, then Laura, Lindsay and I will phone tree call our families.
- If families do not hear from FCS because their power is out and they have not hooked up the direct land-line phone, then they can call 367-2875 or 367-3785 for Erin's and Laura's land lines.
- NOTE: usually if the local schools call a snow day, so does FCS.

Additional Information:

- Under all circumstances, if Forest Charter School does not operate its learning center classes or cooperative classes, the day reverts to a homeschool/independent study day and students should do schoolwork during the day.
- Students taking on-campus classes should check the portal for assignments. Students will still be expected to turn in any work assigned through the portal.
- FCS does not make up snow days due to the structure of our independent study program.
- If you have a meeting scheduled with your supervising teacher, please contact them to confirm that it is cancelled and/or to schedule a new meeting day/time.
