



## Dropping Classes Policy

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### Rationale

Forest Charter School believes that students should honor a commitment to finishing a class for which they signed up. However, FCS acknowledges that students often wish to try various classes in an effort to explore different educational options. Further, although unpredictable circumstances can arise, FCS does not wish to encourage students to drop a class simply because it is difficult. Therefore, FCS has adopted the following policy.

### Policy

- The last day that a student in grades 9-12 may drop a class and not have it appear on a transcript is at the meeting with his or her ST at the end of the second learning period (approximately 8 weeks into a semester).
- If a student wishes to drop a class after the deadline and have the class removed from the transcript, he or she must appeal to the High School Review Board.
