

Forest Charter School Learning Center Behavior Expectations

In order to foster a positive and safe learning environment, Forest Charter School has adopted the following behavioral expectations for all of its learning centers.

- Cell Phones, although permitted on campus, may be confiscated if they disrupt class. Please do not have cell phones out during class
- Students will be expected to respond in a positive manner to the direction or request of all staff members and adults
- At all times, students should help create a physical and emotionally safe learning environment, respecting personal safety, the rights and property of their classmates and others
- Students should be respectful of classmates and teachers at all times.
- Bullying and any other forms of disrespect including cyber-bullying will not be tolerated
- Language should always be school appropriate
- Dress should always be appropriate
 - No short shorts or short skirts unless worn with leggings or tights
 - No undergarments showing
 - No strapless tops
 - **NOTE:** Even if the above criteria is met, attire can still be deemed not school appropriate by school staff.
- Shoes must be worn at all times – No bare feet
- Parents are required to arrange to have their students picked up in a timely manner after the student's last block class/co-op of the day. Please respect the time of the staff
- Alcohol, Tobacco, Drugs, or any related evidence, paraphernalia or clothing are strictly prohibited
- All students need to follow FCS internet expectations as per Technology Agreement
- Excessive displays of affection are prohibited
- For grades K-8 Forest Charter School is a closed campus
- For Grades 9-12, Forest Charter School is an open campus; however, off campus privileges can be revoked

Students who violate any part of the above expectations will receive appropriate disciplinary action from the administration, teacher or appropriate staff member. These measures may be, but are not necessarily limited to the following:

- An informal warning from teacher or administrator
- A personal conference or review board meeting
- Rearrangement of block class schedule
- Development of an additional contract of expected future behavior
- Removal of block class/co-op privileges
